

Early Childhood 3

The curriculum for the Early Childhood 3 (EC3) program has been developed such that cognitive skills are acquired through developmentally appropriate activities. We have also recently implemented the Frog Street curriculum for early childhood students: a multidisciplinary approach which gives special attention to a child's social and emotional development. Students in EC3 follow a daily routine consisting of, but not limited to; large and small group instruction, individual instruction, and time spent in learning centers such as iPads, Math centers, Languages centers, and hands on experiences which allow for the freedom of exploration. There are also structured opportunities that foster social interaction.

Our classroom is self-sufficient which enables us to have lunch, restroom breaks, and easy access to the early childhood playground within a bright, airy, safe and nurturing environment.

Our special out-of-class activities include: Motor Development, Music, Chapel, Godly Play, and Library.
