Annual Fund

The Annual Fund helps bridge the gap between tuition revenue and the actual cost of educating a child at OHES. This difference is close to \$2,000!

The Annual Fund was launched in October and ran through the end of June. It is another major fundraiser of Oak Hall Episcopal School. 100% Board participation, 93% faculty and staff participation, and 63% parent participation. In addition there were nearly 40 contributions from grandparents, alumni, and the general community. Our target this year was \$55,000, the total achieved was \$47,059. Phase Two of the Project encompassed installing a security system throughout the School to include motion detectors and glass break in each classroom, main doors, cafeteria, and the gym, front door access control with video intercom, enclosing the upper school playground with a fence, and installing six access controlled doors.

Achievement Tests

Each April, students in Second Grade through Eighth Grade sit the Iowa Tests of Basic Skills (ITBS). The ITBS is a norm-referenced test (NRT). Norm-referenced tests report how a test taker scores compared with other students taking the same test. It is not ‘pass’ or ‘fail’. In addition to showing development from one year to the next, the ITBS is used by the School as a diagnostic tool, helping the teachers individualize instruction.

It is very important to note that norm-referenced tests cannot, and should not, be compared directly with criterion-based tests (CRT), such as that used by the State of Oklahoma public schools. It would be like comparing apples to tennis racquets as the two types of tests (NRT and CRT) are designed to measure different things. Whilst a public school student’s results may show ‘Advanced’, ‘Satisfactory’, ‘Limited Knowledge’, or ‘Unsatisfactory’, an Oak Hall Episcopal School student’s results will show in which percentile (against all other students taking the test) s/he is performing. Because NRT uses percentiles not percentages the scores do not correlate to letter grades. Likewise, a public school’s A – F letter grade does not compare with this School’s NRT percentile.

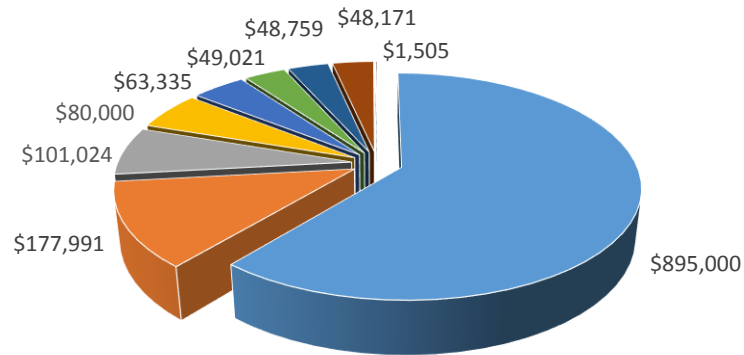

The 2016 results show that on average, our students are performing in the 72 – 84 percentiles of all students undertaking the Iowa Tests of Basic Skills. The Grade Equivalent for each grade is high, and the School’s percentile compared against other schools nationally is also very good (88– 99).

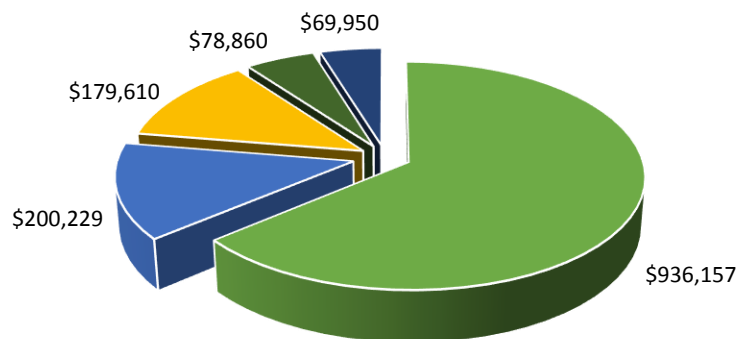
